

### Who is the Commission

- Made-up of ffteen Members seven appointed by the Governor, four by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and four by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.
- · Child Care Commission members serve twoyear terms.
- May be reappointed & serve up to 4 consecutive terms for a total of 8 consecutive years




### How often does the Commission Meet?
