Early Educator Certification (EEC) Overview

- EEC is acknowledgement of an individual's verified level of educational achievement, based on a standardized scale.
- EEC is field wide.
- EEC is required by law for those teaching in or administering licensed early care and education and school age programs.

EEC Basics

- ▶ Application + official transcripts assessed against leveled scale

 - Early Care and Education Professional Scale
 - School Age Professional Scale
 - Adult Educator Endorsement
 - In 2012....Administrator's Endorsement
- ▶ No test & doesn't replace teacher licensure
- ▶ Expires in 3 or 5 years
- ▶ EEC Rewards

Step 1

Identify what technology you need and where it would best serve the overall teaching goals, methods, or strategies.

Step 2

Determine if your audience has the skills to learn online.

10 Best Practices for Teaching Online

- Best practice 1 Be present at the course site.
- Best practice 2 Create a supportive online course community.
- Best practice 3 Develop a set of explicit expectations for your learners and yourself as to how you will communicate and how much time students should be working on the course each week.
- Best practice 4 Use a variety of large group, small group, and individual work experiences.
- Best practice 5 Use synchronous and asynchronous activities.

10 Best Practices for Teaching Online

- Best practice 6 Ask for informal feedback early in the term.
- Best practice 7 Prepare discussion posts that invite responses, questions, discussions, and reflections.
- Best practice 8 Search out and use content resources that are available in digital format if possible.
- Best practice 9 Combine core concept learning with customized and personalized learning.
- Best practice 10 Plan a good closing and wrap activity for the course.
